

# R.D.G.C. COURSE PLAN - 1906

The 1906 plan shows the course reconstruction of 1904. Most of the holes were extended versions of the 1892 layout but the old 3rd hole had been moved to its present position and the old 13th hole had been moved to what is now the 1st hole of the Struie Course.

Play now went as far north as the present 6th hole, which was played across the course to the 7th (the present 11th) green. On the way back the old 8th Short Hole had been discarded and the 11th and 12th holes now followed the line of the present 17th and 18th holes respectively.

The 1904 reconstruction was the brain child of John Sutherland, with an input from J.H. Taylor, five times Open Champion, who was a regular visitor.
