R.D.G.C. COURSE PLAN - 1977

In the 1920's, Donald Ross, on a visit home, remodelled the 1st and 2nd holes in their present form.

The 1977 plan shows the major reconstruction of the course undertaken in 1948. The 6th hole was positioned as it is now. Then five brand new holes, the 7th, 8th, 9th, 10th and 11th, were built on land extending northwards. The new 11th hole finished on the old 6th green and the old short hole, discarded in 1904, was reinstated as the 13th. The final 6 holes of the old course, now unwanted, were included in the new 9 hole Struie Course, since extended to 18 holes.

The 1948 development was to a design of Robbie Grant, Head Greenkeeper, with some advice from George Duncan, the 1920 open Champion.

There has been very little change in the course since 1977.
