## Dornoch Air-Strip

I refer to your recent telephone call and now enclose or append the informatio requested in respect of the use of the Air-Strip.

Scheduled Flights were first operated by Loganair during the summer season commencing 1972 when the first licence was issued by Civil Aviation Authority.

Flights between July and October, 1974 at Dornoch numbered SIX. that is Scheduled flights when it emcumbent on Fire Appliances etc., being manned.

On 22nd November, 1972 Highlands & Islands Development Board informed the Town Council that due to the lack of demand for the service operations would cease as from 6th December, 1972. At that time it was hoped to resume Summer Schedules during 1973, however this service was never resumed. Accordingly since that date, apart from the occasions when all the equipment is inspected and taken out on the Air-Strip for exercises it has not been necessary to use the equipment for Scheduled Flights.

During 1973 the income from the Air-Strip amounted to £48.00 whereas expenditure was £200. This is for the period from May 1973 to May,1974.

Expenditure (known) during 1974-75 will be as follows:-

This does not include cutting of grass which could be in the region of £100

Income in respect of landing sees is estimated at £65.00 for the period to My 1975.

One further point perhaps that should be mentioned is the fact that final costs have not yet been presented in respect of the development of the Air-Strip.
