Conclude

- 1) Up until early 18th c anyway, probably later, Hstle was part of the Barony of Proncy & did not belong to Skibo
- 2) But in 1557 Ullest is included in the lands of Skibo, listed between Sythera and Ferretoun with Ardalles which I take to be the point (Ard) of Allest or Ullest - thus: Sythera, Ullest, Ardalles, Ferretoun with boar and ferry. Then comes Dawatsin, Drumdeware, then Ach Auchi reyach with its pendicles Cuthegermoloye and Auchene colas (which I take to be Achwaich with Achornlary and Achosnich). Neyr is the mill of Skibo and the Bishop's Palace of Dornoch
