### THE VISION

To promote community resilience, ensuring the Dornoch area is a place where the physical, emotional, social and spiritual needs of anyone and everyone are recognised and met.

### THE AIM

To offer a safe space where all will be accepted, supported and encouraged.

### THE HOW

Providing a cosy hub where friendships will be made and strengthened within and across the generations.

Providing new and more appropriate facilities for the organisations and groups currently using the hall, including Common Ground (for adults with learning difficulties), Youth Cafe,

Natter and Nosh, youth organisations etc..

Facilitating specialised therapeutic services for addictions, bereavement, relationships and mental health.

Offering the services of a Parish Nurse,

who will work in collaboration with the local Health Centre and under the umbrella of the National Organisation of Parish Nurses.

### THE WHY

A survey was conducted throughout the local area in which the various age ranges identified gaps in provision in our community.

Creag Mhor will address these gaps.

Consultation has also taken place with health providers, the local council and the schools.

The Project has grown in response to the expressed needs of young and old in the area

and of the professionals working in our community.

### THE CURRENT FACILITIES

While the Hall is well used at present, the age of the building and the use of the space severely limits the wider resource it could be.

We know this because new initiatives we have already taken, and those we need to pursue, have already highlighted the hall's shortcomings. Expenditure on the fabric will offer these groups and others much needed, suitably equipped, smaller and larger gathering spaces.


### THE EMPLOYMENT POTENTIAL



### THE TARGET


We need to raise £150,000 locally, which is 15% of the overall projected cost.
