Dornoch is one of the truly great courses which is an equal joy to the mighty and the mediocre.



Burghfield has been run by the Currie family since 1946 and is renowned for its friendly and informal atmosphere.


There are 48 bedrooms - 16 in the main building and 32 in the new wing and annexe, some with private bathrooms.
