THE CURRENT BUILDING

The church building was opened in 1844 and has been used continuously since then. However the building faces a number of limitations. It has insufficient and inflexible space, an antiquated heating system, poor accessibility, a tiny kitchen, a single toilet and inadequate lighting.

THE PROPOSED BUILDING

The internal layout of the building will be made into two levels. The ground floor will consist of:

- Main entrance into a large foyer
- A large multi-purpose area of 151 sq.m.
- A new large kitchen
- Single level floor & disabled toilet
- Additional toilets
- Office space

The second floor will be accessed by a staircase and lift and will have:

- Auditorium able to seat 335 people

A new heating system and new lighting will be installed throughout.

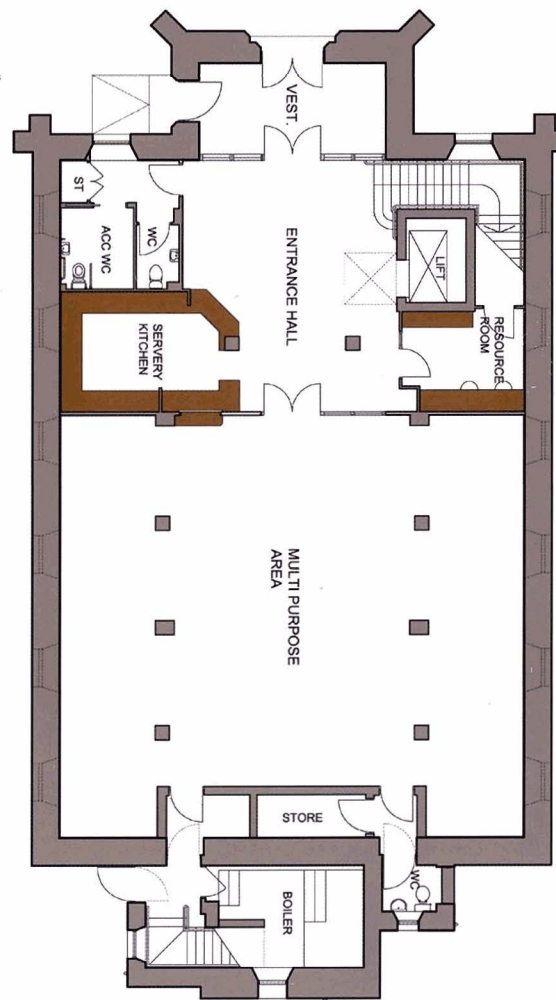
When completed, this building will offer greater flexibility and more space to serve both congregation and community.

THE NEED

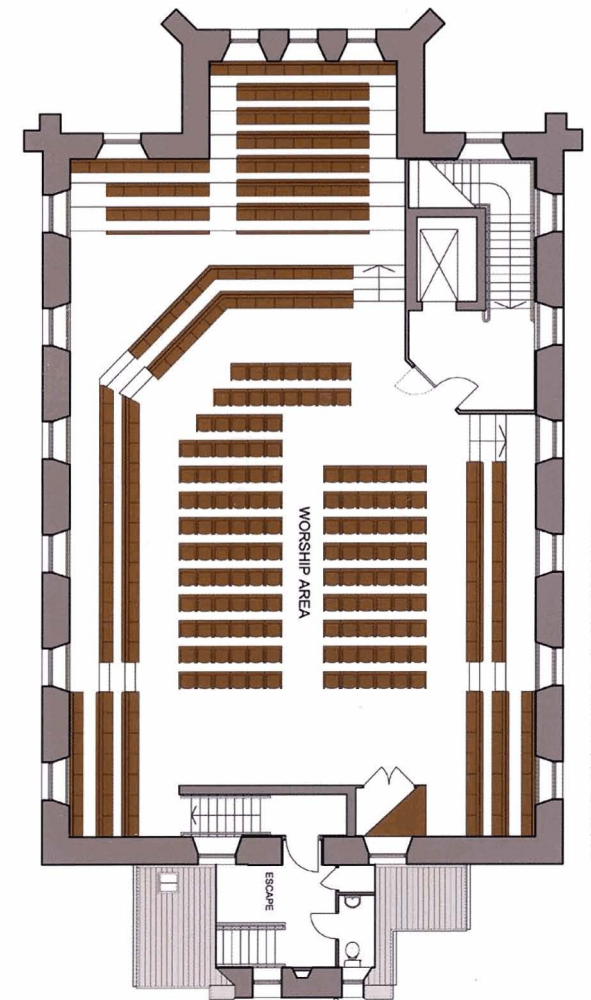

To create a multi-purpose building that will be a useful and adaptable asset for both congregation and for all ages across the community.

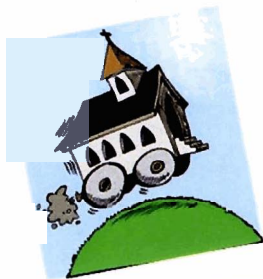


GROUND FLOOR
