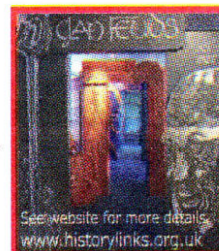


is just a short walk from the Cathedral, behind the Dornoch Castle Hotel.
