Hat-trick of wins for Dornoch's top amateur

DORNOCH'S top amateur golfer, Chris Mailley, recorded a first and a hat-trick of wins last weekend both at home and away commencing on Saturday, in a curtailed Sinclair Cup open competition over the Royal Dornoch
