## Annual Conference and Exhibition of Aerodrome Equipment, Supplies and Services.

I have pleasure in informing you that the above Conference and Exhibition will take place at the Central Hall, Westminster, London, S.W.1. on the 20th, 21st and 22nd January, 1937.

/ I attach hereto a preliminary programme of the arrangements, and shall be glad to know at an early date whether your municipality wishes to appoint delegates to the Conference and Exhibition, and if so, would you please send me the names and the addresses of the delegates, to which any further communications, tickets etc. should be sent. For this purpose, you will find attached a form of application for tickets which should be filled in, signed and returned to me as early as possible.

With regard to the charges in connection with the Conference, the Committee which is organising it, has fixed the amount of £1.15. 0d for each delegate. This fee will include all the charges to meet the expenses of the Conference, and will cover the various visits and functions in connection therewith.

It should be noted that on this occasion, the afternoon of Thursday the 21st January, will be devoted to a General Discussion on various matters which are of importance and interest to aerodrome owners. It has been felt that this will be a more useful way of occupying the time of delegates, than asking them to listen to papers. On the other hand, it may be possible to distribute for information, one or two papers of interest, but these will not necessarily be read.

The Exhibition of Aerodrome Equipment which is being held again this year, is of outstanding interest, because this is the only occasion on which all the various kinds of aerodrome apparatus are gathered together in one place, and this exhibition should not be missed by any municipality, company, or person interested in the running of an aerodrome.


A catalogue of the exhibits will be issued free to delegates in due course.

The Exhibition and the Conference are being held in the same building, and ample time is being allowed for visits to the Exhibition.

This year, delegates will visit Hatfield Aerodrome, Herts., which is one of the privately owned aerodromes, outside London. Lunch will be provided at the Aerodrome.
