Printmakers meet up for some 'double drawing' at Historylinks

RAYMOND Arnold, an Australian printmaker and painter of international reputation, visited Historylinks museum in Dornoch recently, to meet up with artist Ian Westacott.

Ian, also Australian, has lived in Dornoch for many years and like Ray is a printmaker of international standing. Most years they meet up either in Europe or Australia to work on joint

projects. Some years ago two prints of their work were gifted to Historylinks where their "double printing" technique is used to great effect.

Agreeing on a subject, their two

separate drawings are printed directly on top of each other to give a lively and free image.
