A petrol station is also at your service and your further requirements are amply catered for by the restaurant, cocktail bar and sun lounge with television for the occasional wet evening. The public bar is part of the original cottage and Grannie Cumming's own chair is on display in the cocktail bar. And all this is within a minute or so from your caravan or tent.
