I refer to your above quoted letter dated 19th. April, 1988 regarding your proposals to reconstruct Sutherland Road.

As requested, I am returning one copy of your Plan No. 301/1 showing the approximate position of this Department's plant. Subject to the finished levels and the depth of the reconstruction work, I do not anticipate that there will be any alterations needed to our plant which would be chargeable to your Department. I must draw your attention to the fact that the sever which is already bedded and surrounded in concrete is particularly shallow and care must be taken during your works to prevent any damage to the pipes. It is possible that some of the house connections may be affected by your works, in which case the cost of any alterations will be charged to you on a time and materials basis.

Haturally we shall expect you to take care with all the surface boxes and ensure that they are re-set to suit the finished levels of carriageways and footpaths.

It is possible that we may wish to renew some water connections to properties fronting Sutherland Road during the course of your works but I'm sure that such work can be organised without any interference with the progress of your Contract.

Sutherland Road, Dornoch - Road Reconstruction

I refer to the meeting held at your Brora Offices on Wednesday, 22nd. March, 1989, between Messrs. Munro and Moore of our respective Departments, concerning the above road reconstruction and the implications with respect to the integrity of the water main.

I confirm the conclusions of the aforementioned meeting as follows:-

- The length of the existing main from Cromartie Road to the terminal 1. scour will be diverted in 80mm diameter uPVC, clear of your new kerbline, by my Dornoch operational staff.
- Your appointed contractor will supply excavator and operative for the 2. mainlaying.
- My Division will finance the extension of the diverted main from a point adjacent to the existing terminal scour, in Sutherland Road, to the To this end I would be pleased to westerly end of your intended works. receive your contractor's rate for excavating a pipetrack track for an 80mm diameter pipe to a depth of 900mm below finished road level.
- The concrete surround on the existing fireclay sewer is to be replaced between the terminal manhole, adjacent to the District Council Housing, and the manhole at the entrance to the West Church Hall Car Park.
- My Division will finance the connection of an 80mm diameter uPVC pipe 5• into the terminal manhole, together with the laying of an 80mm diameter pipe from this connection to a point at the commencement of the grass verge on the north side of Sutherland Road. My Dornoch Office will supply the materials for this work, to be carried out by your contractor at a cost to be notified before commencement of the work.

In connection with item (1), I have opened a rechargeable code payable by your Department on completion of the appropriate section of the work.
