Munro & Grant, Butchers, Dornoch; Mrs. Betty MacGulloch, Allt a Mhuilinn, Dornoch; Dornoch Golf Links Hotel Ltd., 2 Inglis Street, Inverness; John H. Sutherland, 13 Bishopfield, Dornoch; The Town Council of The Royal Burgh of Dornoch; and The County Council of the County of Sutherland.~~

and upon The Provost, Magistrates, and Council of said City and Royal Burgh, for the public interest,—Respondents,—and to appoint them to lodge Answers thereto, if so advised within a certain short space: Thereafter,

if considered necessary, to visit the premises, and on resuming consideration hereof, with or without Answers, to grant warrant to the Petitioner to (1) Convert part of the recreation room into an American Bar. This will necessitate the construction of a wall to divide the bar from the recreation room and the cutting of a new door in the corridor to enable supplies to be taken into the bar. (2) Improve the approach to the reception office by (a) removing the existing counter and partition and building a wall, and (b) making new opening and erecting counter with flat extension and roll shutter to close the opening. (3) Remove the existing public telephone box and use the available space as a cloakroom. (4) Build new partition wall in Manager's Office, make openings in existing wall and erect two new telephone boxes in front of said office.
