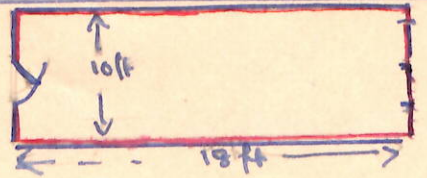
I have to-day received by

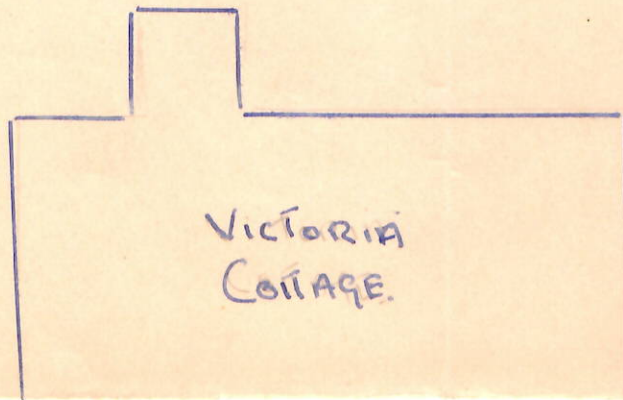
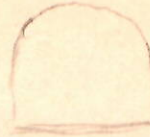
