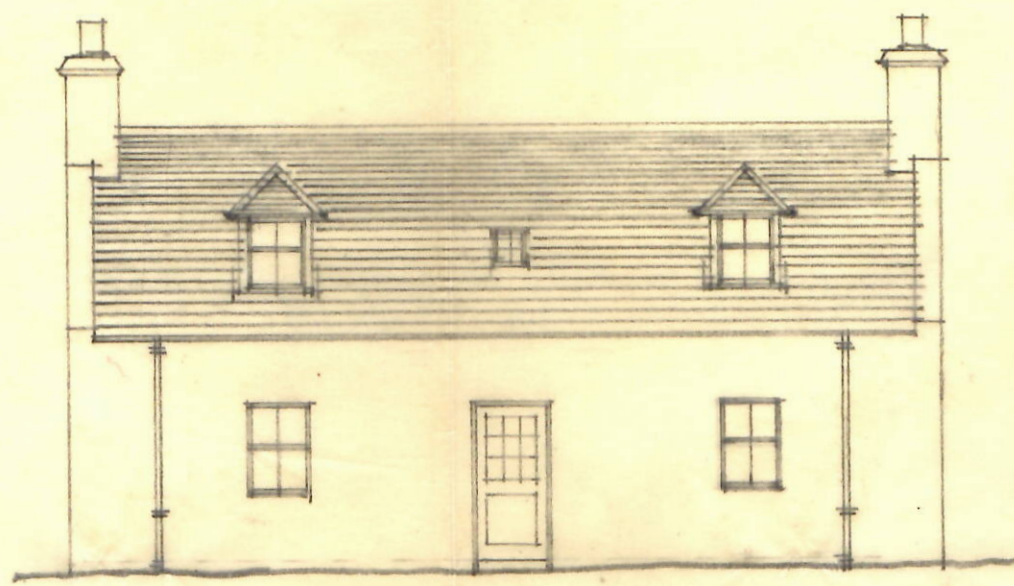

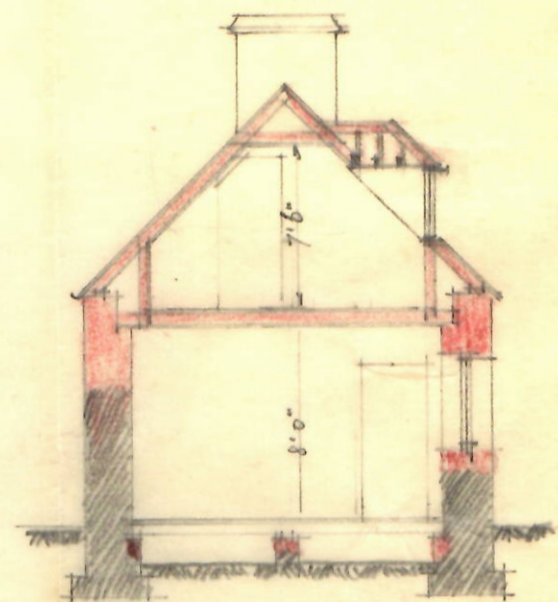

PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

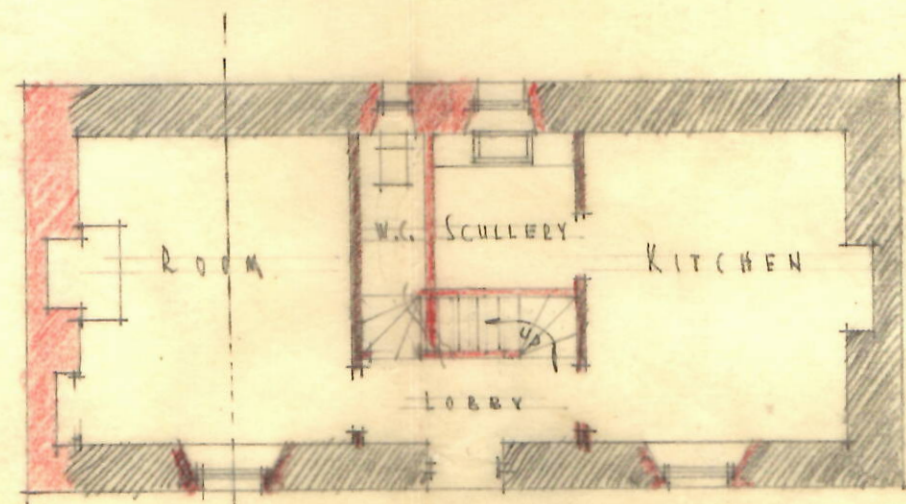
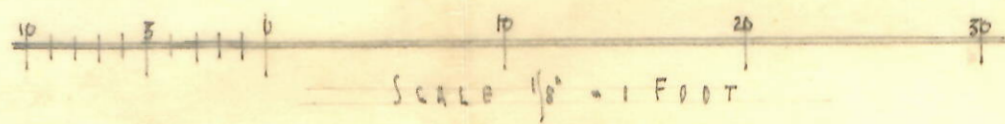

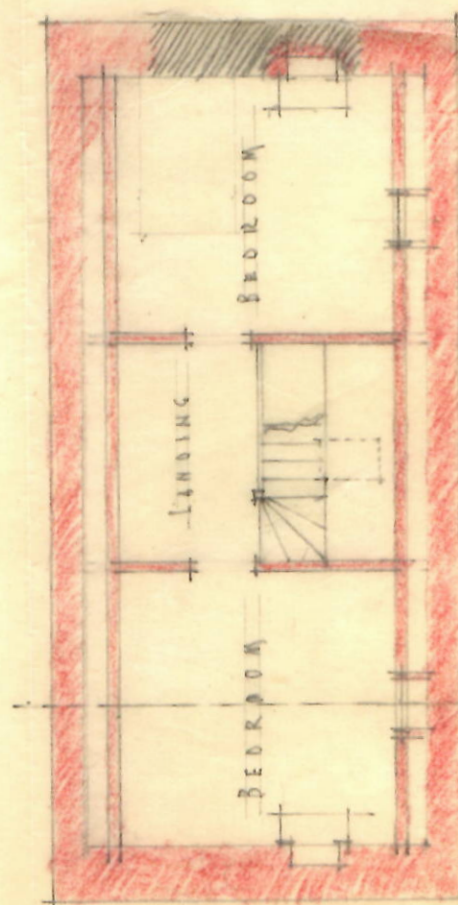
ELEVATION
