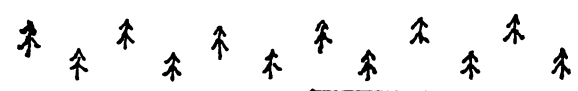
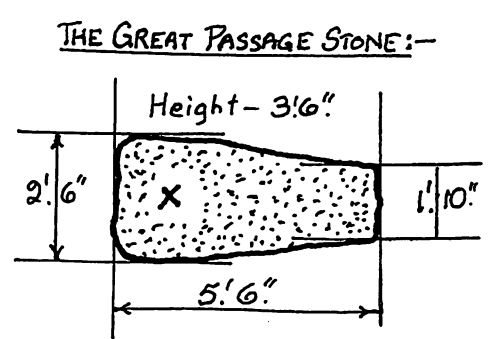
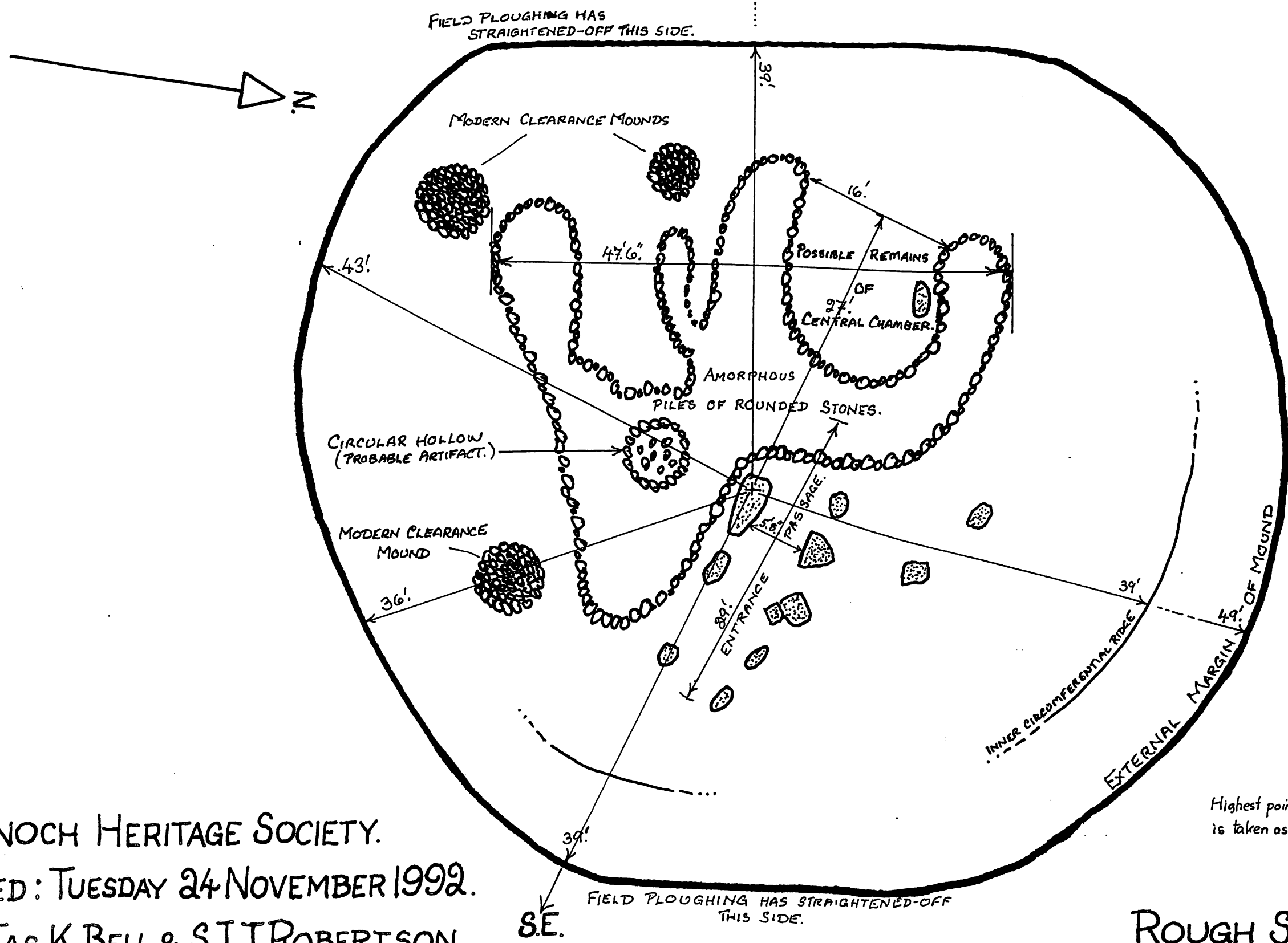
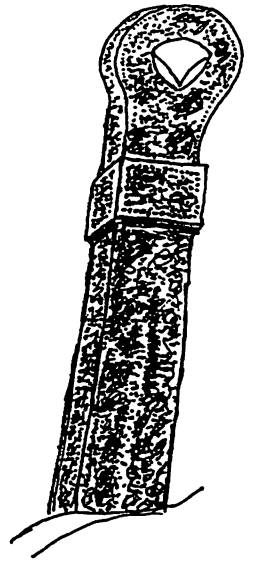


CHAMBERED CAIRN (RUINS OF) EVELIX FARM, BY EAST-END OF LOWER CLASHMORE PLANTATION.

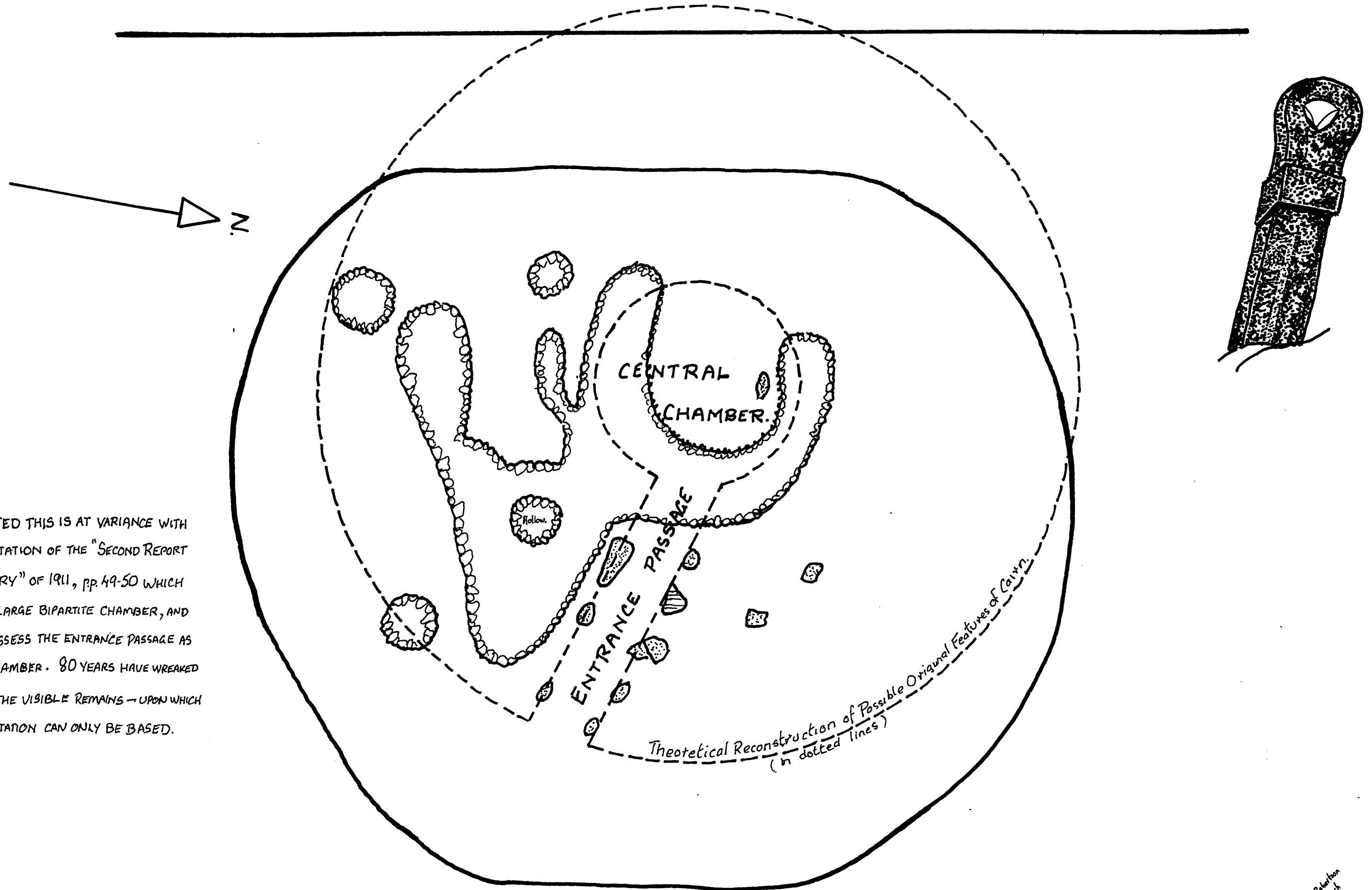
Highest point of the Great Stone of the Entrance Passage is taken as approximate central point for mensuration. (NOT TO SCALE).
