### CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

We were all saddened by the death of our Caretaker Donald Maclean earlier in the year. We are indebted to him for many years hard work well beyond the call of duty. It was impossible to replace the full service he had offered and accordingly some changes were introduced and the main effect of this is that a key is now lodged at the Police Station so that booking organisations can let themsevles in and out of the building. An additional light switch has been provided just inside the main hall entrance and an unlocked key cupboard has been built in the lobby to provide easy access to store cupboards etc.

A number of regular bookings have now been established, namely Dancing Club, Bowling, Cubs & Scouts, Youth Club and twice weekly vet surgery. A slimmimng club is soon to start and a monthly travelling cinema has been booked. Occasional bookings have included dances, coffee mornings, comercial sales and weekend accomodation for youth groups. The revenue from hires together with some fund raising has enabled us to meet the running costs and carry out some repairs.

With no separate Entertainments Committee the fund raising events have been reduced to an annual Top Team Competition, Auction, Games Night Dance and Barbeque following the Half Marathon.

The Youth Club has again been well attended; sessions are now once a week on Thursday evenings from 7-9. A tape recorder known as a "Ghetto Blaster" has been purchased and is much enjoyed by the youngsters. The Pool Table and darts boards are being well used.

Due to considerable damage incurred with licenced dances, new conditions have been imposed and booking organisations have to pay £100 deposit (to cover excess on the insurance premium) and return the following day to clean the building.

My thanks to all the Committee for their hard work over the year, to Caretaker Barry Turner, to Maggie Hill for handling the bookings and to the Affiliated Clubs and the community as a whole for their continuing support of the Social Club.
