



HOTEL AT DORNOCH GUTTED BY FIRE



So much interest was created by the photograph we recently reproduced of the old Sutherland Arms Hotel at Dornoch that two others have come to light, both from the home of Mr Robert McCulloch, Carnaig Street, who died last month.
