- 1 It is strange that the receiving house is only named though it must have existed from 1871 to 1885
- 2 There can only have been one Hugh McKenzie although he is variously described as farmer and carpenter..lt is also surprising that such a man should be -presumably in charge - at the receiving house.
- 3 It seems likely that Hugh McKenzie died during 1884-5 and Thomas Logan became postman but whether that means that the receiving house was demolished then is pure speculation. It was certainly not mentioned in the 1891 census but it had not been mentioned in the 1871 census when it presumably existed.
- 4 the search therefore has notrevealed very much!
