Besides what's @mentioned the Purf. Mr Glass has been put to very Considerable Charges & Expences on acct^o of this Proce^{ss}, having been obliged to go to Sutherland once and to Edin^o twice on that acct^o each of which Journeys from Aberdeen shire the place of his Residence must have cost him not less than £4^l. besides loss of Time & Business, and being by Trade a Mer^{ch} had he got pay^t of his money when due he certainly could have made at least double int^o of it, which would at this Time be about £8^l. more than common Interest. But these his Damages he chuses to restrict altogether to the Sum of 10
