Account paid Bailie Kenneth Sutherland in Dornoch for sundry furnishings and outlays on account of the Burgh.

7 Nov. 1760. To Candles furnished the Guard that attended Alexander Gordon, Dumb, by Mr Gilchrist's orders.

N.B. There was a chair made by Bailie Kenneth for the Dumb of Embo for securing him when mad as the prison's were not sufficient for that purpose; that Sir John Gordon grudges to bear the whole expense as it can be useful to the town on future occasions, it is proposed that the town should pay a part of the expense and in doing so he is willing to dispense with the chair in the town's favours, which he values at £3 st.
