- 1545 Denald Redavid MAIR
- 1565 John Gray of Swordale and Elizabeth BARCLAY his wife made Gustodians of 1576 Skibo Castle Joint Constables to them and their heirs and assignees.
- 1552 Master Thomas "BRYDY, bought the north part of a house situated in the City of Dornoch, extending in length to 40 feet from the west gable of the said house to the entry of the exceetery of 5t. Pinnbar on the North and thence extending in breadth from the said cemetery to the burn running before and descending through the said Sity as far as the high water mark.
- 1563 Robert ReDonald Redavid (alias Robert Duf) sold to Mr. Thomas "BRODIE" and his heirs, his garden on the east side of the City of Dornoch with his house on the west side of that garden.
- Gavine) BORTHWICK, Dean for 40 years. Resigned in 1607. Evidently vacated residence of Beanery before 1607 because in 1587 John Munro, writer, was granted the Manse of the Bean. The grant was made by the King who, by Act of Ammeration in 1587, had power to dispose of and/or appropriate residences of the dergy.
- 1601 A new grant of the Barldon of Butherland by King James VI to Barl John.

  The whole of the lands of the Bishopric of Caithness were included in this new grant, including Skibo and others in the Parish of Dormoch.
