Sold out of the 19th Reg: 1777 & accepted
adjutantcy of West Norfolk Militia.

Commanded by the eccentric Earl of
Oxford

Died at Colchester Jan 7 1804

He married Jan 15 1760. Sarah only daughter
of Crosby Westfield. B.N. 14 children

His eldest son was William Gordon born
1764 Ensign 19th Foot died 1794

Succeeded by 5th son. Sir John D Bart.
Born 1776 (!) Succeeded 1804

Son of Gordon 1748. He succeeded father
of Tobols for the lands of Little Tobols.
He won the Cross 1781.

to pay some debt - had to borrow
from Lord Reay.
