Minute of Meeting of the Committee
of the Boy Scouts Organisation,
held at Dornoch on Tuesday,
20th day of June 1911

(Present: Provost MacLachlan,
Messrs J. Hourston: and J. H.
Arthur, also Mr. J. A. Cameron,
Provost MacLachlan in the chair.

The Honorary Secretary, (Mr. Arthur,) reported
that eighteen boys had been enrolled and
had passed the first test, and were therefore
entitled to the Tenderfoot Badges. He however
pointed out, that the boys could not be
enrolled until the County Association was
formed, and it was resolved to form a
County Association with a Commissioner and
Honorary Secretary. The Marquis of Stafford
was nominated Commissioner for the County,
and Mr. Arthur was appointed Honorary
