Dear Sir,

I am to propose at the annual meeting of the Golf Club to be held shortly, that the Golf course, instead of being extended towards Inver, should be kept within the Burgh boundaries as much as possible.

Two additional holes will be necessary if the Club adopt my proposal, and I now beg to apply for the sanction of the Town Council for the same. One will be in the vicinity of the old target butt, the other immediately below the Quarries and close to the eastmost

house in Littletown. This arrangement will enable us to dispense with two of the present holes on the portion of the links beyond the ~~parliamentary~~ ^{parliamentary} boundaries of the Burgh.
