

I enclose you herewith Copy of a Letter, which I have today sent to the Secretary for Scotland. I am instructed by my Committee to state that in various other cases where similar applications have been made to the Secretary for Scotland the Club have offered, and the applied Authorities have accepted, Notice Posts for erection at the entrances to the areas proposed to be restricted, asking that motor vehicles will be driven slowly, and it has generally, I believe/

believe been found that in this way the results said to be attained by the application have been secured without imposing restrictions or obtaining special regulations. I am instructed to state that if your Council are prepared to consider a suggestion of this nature, my Committee will be glad to make a somewhat similar proposal in this case.
