



Additional Work at School Hill



General Conditions of Contract

Any contract entered into shall be subject, where applicable, to the General Conditions of Contract for use in connection with Works of Civil Engineering Construction as published by the Institution of Civil Engineers and as amended or revised, except where these conditions are expressly varied in the tender, or herein.

Terms of Payment

All prices quoted are nett, unless otherwise stated.
Accounts will be rendered monthly and payment, which will not be subject to deduction of retention, is to be made within 28 days of submission of the account. An interest charge of 1½% above current bank rate will be made for any additional time to pay.

Extra Cost

In the event of suspension or interruption of the works by any instruction or lack of instruction by the Client, or any disturbance or disruption of the progress of our works for any reason whatsoever outwith our control, any loss or extra cost thereby incurred by us shall be chargeable to the Client.

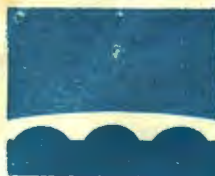
Except where expressly stated otherwise any work carried out shall be maintained for a period of 6 months.





We refer to previous correspondence and are pleased to submit our lump sum offer amounting to £4950.00 for the construction of the above roadway, which would run parallel to and adjacent to the existing footpath.

Our price covers the construction of a carriageway approximately 230'0" long by 14'0" wide, together with a 6'0" wide footpath on one side.


On the carriageway we have allowed for a 6" depth of bottoming, 2½" depth of 1½" nominal size bitmac finished with pre-coated grit, with 10" x 5" hydraulically pressed road kerbs on each side of the carriageway, set on concrete and with concrete haunching. Two road gullies would be required which we assume can be connected to soakaways also to be provided by us.

We have allowed for a 4" depth of bottoming on the footpath and 1¼" depth of ¾" bitmac. The heel of the footpath would be retained by a 6" x 2" concrete kerb.


