A very aesthetic masonry wall has recently been constructed at Easdale. Possibly because there was the very dilapidated remains of a wooden fence behind the former stone wall, which was much lower, it was decided to erect a wire fence on the new wall. This new fence will consist of 2' high steel angle irons and three strands of wire. I feel this will make the place look like a prison camp and seriously detract from the pleasant aspect of the wall as seen from the road and golf course. There is absolutely no need for a fence as a protection from animals or trespassers etc and to achieve this anyway barbed wire would be needed. I would therefore ask that the Town Council be told they do not need to erect this fence as the wall is quite sufficient as it is at present. Some other residents further up the road have a fence and the result is quite unpleasant. Easdale is at the end of the road and there will be no 'gap effect'.

I refer to your letter of 5th July, 1973 regarding Dr. Cameron's request that no additional structure be placed on the wall of the garden now tenanted by him at Church Street, shown as Plot No.8 on the plan prepared by your department.

The District Valuer's recommendation on the sale of the ground contained the following condition:-

"That the acquiring Authority will be responsible for re-instating the existing wall and road paving and this boundary, whether it be the existing structure re-erected or a new structure, will become the property of the Vendors who shall continue to be responsible for future maintenance."

Sutherland County Council are the actual owners, accordingly it would be for them to approve of Dr. Cameron's request, Dr. Cameron only being a tenant of the County Council. The Town Council are bound to carry out the agreement made ~~made~~ between the County, however, if the County Council are prepared to agree to Dr. Cameron's request the Town Council will have no objection. Accordingly as previously suggested the matter now rests between Dr. Cameron and the County Council and it is suggested that you obtain the views of the County Clerk on this matter and proceed accordingly.


