## BOARD OF AGRICULTURE FOR SCOTLAND. LAND SETTLEMENT (SCOTLAND) ACT, 1919, PART III.

1. The Board of Agriculture for Scotland hereby make the following Order:-

The Town Council of the Royal Burgh of Dornoch (hereinafter referred to as the Local Authority) are hereby empowered to put in force as respects the land described in the draft lease set forth in the Schedule hereto the powers of compulsory acquisition by leasing of land for allotments conferred by or under the Land Settlement (Scotland) Act, 1919, subject to the provisions of that Act and to the Allotments (Compulsory Leasing) Regulations, 1920, and to the provisions of this Order.

- 2. The tenancy of the Local Authority shall commence on the first day of February Nineteen hundred and twenty-two.
- The power of compulsory leasing conferred by this Order shall cease on the expiration of one year from the date of this Order, unless that period is extended by the Board of Agriculture for Scotland with the approval of the Secretary for Scotland.
- 4. This Order may be cited as the Royal Burgh of Dornoch (Balloan Estate Allotments) Order 1922, and shall come into operation as from the date hereof.
