To the Burgesses of the said Burgh and to the Provost, Bailies, Councellors and Community of the same.

With power to the Burgesses of the said Burgh of choosing and creating annually a Provost, Bailies, Treasurer, Dean of Guild, Councellors, and other Officers, and necessary Members, and of constituting laws and statutes for the preservation of good order within the said Burgh, as is fit and convenient.

26. Dornock.—Charles, 14th July, 1648. Dat potestatem incolis dicti burgi de Dornock, consiliariis, et communitati ejusdem, pro tempore existend. eligendi præpositum, quatuor ballivos, decanum gildæ, thesaurarium, et duodecim consiliarios; cum potestate etiam iisdem consiliariis commissionarios pro Parliamentis nostris eligendi, cum omnibus aliis officiarios pro bono regimine dicti burgi; et similiter facimus præfatos præpositum et ballivos, et suos successores, justiciarios pacis inter ipsos.

Grants power to the Inhabitants of the said Burgh of Dornock, to the Councellors and Community for the time being to choose a Provost, four Bailies, a Dean of Guild, Treasurer, and twelve Councellors; with power also to the same to choose Commissioners for our Parliaments, with all other Officers for the good government of the said Burgh; and likewise we make the aforesaid Provost and Bailies, and their successors, Justices of the Peace among the Inhabitants of said Burgh.
