
Dear Sir,

by the heirs of the late Wth James Gunn.
It measures 45 feet along North & South sides
and 100 feet along East & West sides.

The original description was "Lot of
building ground on the Links of Dornoch
at the North side of the Lot or Farm
of Sandycroft occupied by John Matheson"
No other boundaries are given.

Proposed additions to house
at Sandycroft, Dornoch

I have made various enquiries in regard to the boundaries of the above subjects as instructed by your Court and now enclose the following documents &c for your consideration, viz:-

1. Petition by Mr J. A. Grant.
2. Plan of proposed additions
3. Letter from Sutherland Estates Office dated 20th June last
4. Letter from Mr J.A. Grant dated 27th July last
5. Do. Sutherland Estates to Mr Grant dated 23rd July last.
6. Copy Tack between the Duke of Sutherland and the late Mr John Matheson.

You will observe from the Tack that the measurement of the boundaries are quite clear but the location of the ground is rather obscure as no adequate description of the adjoining property is given. In the circumstances the only point I would draw your attention to is the possible encroachment on the roadway behind the house.
